Director's Note:

Upon learning that I had been sorted into the Puffs' house back in 2004, I was sure a mistake had been made. My brother, who had no idea about this wild world of magic, asked the wizard what in the world it meant that I, his older sister, was a Puff. "It means she's loyal, a good friend, a hard worker, and wants everyone to win!" At the time, that description sounded so benign and boring compared to the Braves or the Smarts.

Here I am, 20 years later, incredibly giddy and proud to embrace all things Puff. Though often overlooked or ignored in the books, this play shines a light on the spirit, silliness, humor, and truth of some of the kindest, most generous characters in the story. The audience has an opportunity to see what was happening in House Puff while Harry and his friends were fighting the forces of evil. The Puffs' loyalty, friendship, and hard work are central to the success of the story, and this irreverent play allows us to laugh at and with the energy of these warm-hearted characters.

I have so loved directing this play, as it makes me laugh out loud every single rehearsal- we have all needed a little magic and a little goodness in our lives as of late. The students have been hard at work on this since





late November, and have enjoyed exploring the different characters and relationships in the story.

Together we have created this whimsical piece of storytelling- throw in the artistry and design of the theatre tech class and we invite you to immerse yourself in the warmth and magic of our story.

I believe the heart and authenticity of the Puffs is what helps good prevail in the world of witches and wizards. May we take that energy out into the real world.


